



LakeCities Ballet Theatre 2022 Tech Schedule for The Nutcracker

The following Rehearsals and Performances are at LAKE DALLAS HIGH SCHOOL and are mandatory in order to perform. The address is 3016 Parkridge Dr. in Corinth, Texas

We are so glad you are a part of our 32nd Annual Nutcracker! Below is the schedule for our mandatory rehearsals in the theater as well as call times for the actual performances. Please highlight the times you will need to be there. If in doubt, please ask! **Beginning SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 20th, all rehearsals are called Tech Rehearsals and are at Lake Dallas High School. Our last studio rehearsal is Saturday, Nov. 19th.** There will be no refund of ticket money or participation fee for those who must be removed from the show for missing a TECH rehearsal. Please remember that there are many differences between this professional production and a recital. You received an email with a Nutcracker Parent packet to print out and take to one of the two PARENT MEETINGS which explained everything you need to know. If you missed our meetings, it is imperative that you print and read the entire packet to make sure you and your child are prepared for tech week and the shows.

1. During these next two weeks, boost your immunity by getting plenty of rest, eat healthy, and drink lots of water.
2. Please read carefully the complete check-in and pick-up policy that will be sent in Friday's email.
3. All cast members including LBT and LBT2 are to check in each day at the check in station in the lobby of the theater (doors facing the south side of the building facing Swisher Rd.) from Sunday, Nov 20 thru Wed, Nov. 23. After you check in these days, proceed to the auditorium and wait to be called onstage.
4. On Friday, Nov 25, for Dress Rehearsal as well for both shows, the check-in station will be moved to the north side entrance of the school facing the football stadium to give dancers easier access to the dressing rooms. At check-in, parent will let us know who will be checking out the dancer at the end of the show.
5. To check out a dancer at intermission or end of the show, the check in station will be moved back to the lobby. The designated person to check out the dancer must show their ID and only one parent/guardian may enter the dressing room hallway. You will then check them out with their respective Room Mom.
6. Dancers may not go out into the lobby for any reason in costume before, during, or after the show. There will be a designated time for dancers to go out to the lobby to take their photos if they wish, but it is before the audience arrives.
7. Dress Rehearsal is closed to the public. Two passes per family will be given to allow parents/guardians to attend dress rehearsal.

Sunday – Nov. 20 – Tech Rehearsal at Theatre! (Theatre Hours: 10:00am to 6:30pm)

8:30am – Load-up! Our LBT CREW DADS will meet at our warehouse at 1306 N. Cowan in Lewisville to help load the trucks. We are able to bring our entire set/props this year so we will need more help. If there are any other Nutcracker Dads who are available to help us, please come to the warehouse at 8:30am. With lots of manpower, it should take about an hour.

10:00am – Our LBT CREW DADS will then arrive at Lake Dallas HS and unload the trucks and start assembling the big props. Bring your favorite screw driver if you like. LBT and LBT2 Dancers will rest that morning and arrive at Noon to help. Again, any Nutcracker Parents who are available to help, please come to the theater at noon, or even prior to your rehearsal. There's plenty to do and decorate!

12:00pm to 4:00pm – LBT and LBT2 Dancers needed to help hang drops and decorate. Rats and Clara leave to start warming up at 3:15.

3:45pm to 5:15pm – BATTLE SCENE – ALL! Room Moms: Put Mouse bodies & Soldier hats on dancers in the theater Mon thru Wed.

5:15pm to 6:00pm – ROOM MOM MEETING! Meet Ms. Carla in the lobby of the theater. All Room Moms must attend one meeting.

5:15pm to 5:45pm – MOTHER GINGER & POLICHINELLES / LITTLE POLLY (Polis, Guardian Angels come early to warmup)

5:45pm to 6:30pm – ANGEL SCENE – ALL! Sleigh Attendants, Clara and Prince needed for All Angel Scene rehearsals

(No Party Scene, No Snow Scene, No Diverts today.)

6:15pm to 8:00pm – Run ACT 2 (Angel Scene only from 5:30pm to 6:15pm)

10:15am to 12:30pm – PARTY AND BATTLE – ALL! We will do two run-thrus of Party and Battle. Those in Party will be done by 12:15pm (Dolls and Clara's Friends should arrive by 9:30am to do your own warmup)

12:15pm to 12:30pm – SNOW PAS

11:45am to 1:00pm – Class for LBT, LBT2, Men and ALL pointe roles. (LOCH)

Class starts in lobby from 12:00pm to 12:30pm and finish class onstage from 12:30pm to 1:00pm

1:00pm to 2:00pm – RUN SNOW SCENE – ALL! **SNOW CHOIR NEEDS TO ATTEND THIS REHEARSAL!**

2:15pm to 4:30pm – ACT 2 – We will start with Bows and then you can leave when you are done with your divert if you are not in Finale.

Please Remember!!! Dress Rehearsal is closed. Each family will receive two passes so that the parents or guardians may watch.

7:30pm DRESS REHEARSAL BEGINS!

*Dancers who are not in Act 2 may be picked up at intermission. Dancers will be supervised until the end of the show, so if parents have a ticket to the show, they may wait to pick up their dancer at the end of the show. No one may be picked up during an Act. Checking out a child will only be done at intermission or the end of the show. At check-in, Parents must list the name of the parent/guardian who will be picking up the dancer and that person must show their ID when picking up. Performers may not go into the lobby before, during or after the show in costume. Please bring a nice coverup or studio warmup to change into after they perform, especially if they are planning to go into the lobby to meet guests.

4:45pm – Check in for those in Class. Class on stage for LBT/LBT2, ALL Pointe Roles and Men from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm (ROSE)

5:45pm to 6:00pm – Check in for ALL in Act 1 **(This includes Snow Angel and Bakers in Snow Choir who may check in at 6:30pm)**

Notes at 6:45pm for Party and Battle in Dressing Room. Snow Choir Warmup after Notes.

7:00pm – Check in for those only in Act 2 (Angels, Cherubs, Bakers and Russian)

7:30pm – PERFORMANCE BEGINS!

*Dancers who are not in Act 2 may be picked up at intermission. Notes at 1:30pm for Party and Battle in Dressing Room. Snow Choir Warmup after Notes.

1:30pm – Check in for those only in Act 2 (Angels, Cherubs, Bakers and Russian)

2:00pm – PERFORMANCE BEGINS! *Same pick up information as above.

STRIKE!!! All LBT and LBT2 dancers and Room Moms are required to help with strike. Clean your area carefully and leave it as you found it. Parents, especially Dads are needed to help the girls strike the heavy set pieces. Strike will go quicker with many hands!
